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

### Sound It Out

Stretch out the word. Make each sound in the word as you read it.

The k-a-n-g-a-r-o-o hops.

## Cover Part of the Word

Cover part of the word with your hand. Read the part you can see first and then try to read the next part.

The umbiguity is green.

## Ask yourself if it makes sense

Read the word in the sentence. If it doesn't make sense, try reading the sentence again with another word that makes sense.

### The trumpet makes a loud sound.

# Try the other sound the vowel makes

Read the word using the short vowel sound and if it doesn't make sense, try it using the long vowel sound.

The tape is sticky.
